If within 3 years after the date of receipt of a contribution of property for which CommonSpirit Health was required to sign Form 8283 on your behalf (i.e., donated property over \$5,000), the property is sold, exchanged, or otherwise disposed, CommonSpirit Health must file an information return with the IRS on Form 8282 (Donee Information Return) and send you a copy of the form.
